We will sail from Mallaig on the 'Western Isles' ([www.knoydart-ferry.co.uk/](http://www.knoydart-ferry.co.uk/)) up Loch Nevis, including a stop at Inverie. We will get the Cal Mac ferry from Armadale to Mallaig at 8.50am and return on the 6pm ferry, getting back to Armadale for 6.30pm. **Please meet at Armadale no later than 8.30am.** The £20 fee for the trip does not include Cal Mac ferry fares- individuals must pay this themselves. Our places on the ferry have been reserved though. Those of you eligible for free travel on the Cal Mac ferry must bring your Highland Regional Passes to do so. Bring warm clothing, waterproofs, decent footwear and sensible safety extras with you. We hope the tearoom (or pub!) will be open, but come prepared with some food & drink just in case.
